2020**What is ILC<sup>2</sup>?**

Initiatives in Lung Cancer Care (ILC<sup>2</sup>) is an exciting Lung Ambition Alliance program that aims to support patient and caregiver non-profit organizations. It seeks to deliver initiatives that will improve the quality of care and close gaps in the patient experience of lung cancer care around the world. ILC<sup>2</sup> will fund innovative, promising, and proven projects around the world that can be supported and scaled to transform patient identification, quality of care, and patient outcomes.

**What is the time window to apply?**

Applications must be submitted online from November 2, 2020 to December 31, 2020.

**Who is eligible to apply?**

Registered charitable/not-for-profit organizations focused on lung cancer care are eligible. ILC<sup>2</sup> is not open to individuals.

**What will be funded?**

Funded projects must aim to improve the quality of care for lung cancer patients. They must be able to demonstrate measurable outcomes. Projects would need to commence within 6 months of an award being granted and be completed within 1 year (or 2 years for the projects requesting the highest funding).

**How much funding can be applied for?**

There are three categories of funding available, up to a maximum of \$100,000 per application. The categories vary according to the size of the applicant organization, the project, and the intended scale and impact.
